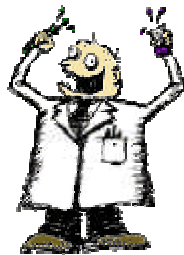

## Pinewood Derby Schedule

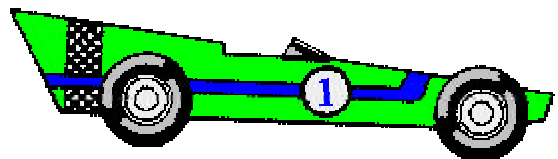
### Pinewood Derby Setup

### Coffee and Donuts

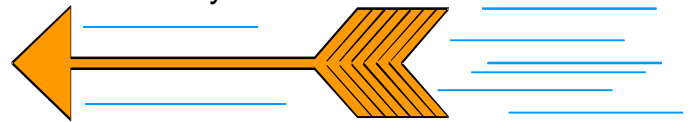
On Sunday, February 4, Scouts Host Coffee/Donuts – Full uniform required. The following assignments have been made:
