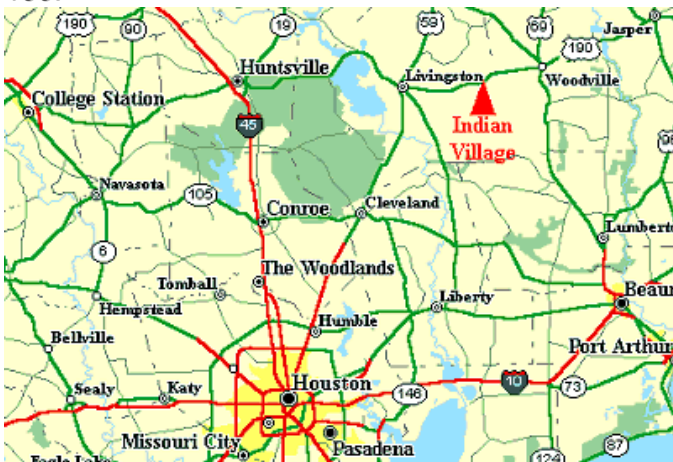

## Medical Forms Required For **EVERYONE**

All forms for children **MUST** have immunization dates and be signed by parent. "Up To Date" listing for immunizations will not be accepted. The form does **NOT** have to be signed by a doctor. Forms for parents do not need immunization dates.

All leaders should have a copy of these forms and the original should be given to Ted Winter. Make sure your Den # is on the form.
